**Rotary House Land Lease** - A brief outline: We own the building but lease the land from Council. The lease terminates on 31<sup>st</sup> of May 2028. Thereafter there is provision for a month by month extension should both parties want this. We may terminate the lease without any penalty. We must maintain the premises and keep them clean and tidy (excluding fair wear and tear). We must have Public Liability Insurance of \$2 million and ensure the building at full value. We pay all utilities. We can't make major alterations without permission from the council.
