A self serve meal was enjoyed and after a good fellowship session President Kathryn formally welcomed our guests: Rob Vigor-Brown, a Rotarian from Rotarua and board member of the Lakes District Health Board and Helen Manning, retired paramedic and prospective member.

President Kathryn then reported on the Motor Neuron Disease charity walk. Ten Rotarians and partners provided support services to the organizers, recording participants, collecting monies providing auction assistants and undertaking walk safety supervision. Some 130 people took part in the walk including at least 4 sufferers of the debilitating disease. Lead organizer, Tony Treloar, himself a sufferer, sent a letter thanking Lake Taupo Rotary for their assistance and advising that in excess of \$10,000 had been raised for the cause.



A vote of thanks was offered to Doug Simmons for making his show home available for our Sunday Afternoon Social and also to Maureen Bayley for organizing the food and refreshments.

Mary Legg was acknowledged for dealing with the condition of Rotary House after a wedding last Saturday night. Unfortunately the hirer did not respect the condition of the hire and will be charged for the additional cleaning necessary to make the hall suitable for the Church group that uses the facility on Sundays.

Dennis Jenkins then conducted the Sergeant's session with all members feeling the sting and being asked to pay a fine for various misdemeanors'. It was moved that the Sergeant's collection and the current contents of the 'shrapnel' container be donated to the Motor Neuron Disease Fund and all present agreed.
